REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Dates:

- Priority Registration for students already enrolled in Chapelwood School for Young Children begins April 26, 2011.
- Open Enrollment for all students begins May 9, 2011.
- Prorated rates will be offered to students who enroll in classes after October 1, 2011.
- Classes begin Tues, Sept 6th and end Fri, Dec 9th (Gymnastics and Tae Kwon Do classes run through Dec 14, 2011).

Holidays/School closings: There will be no enrichment classes on these dates

- Mon, October 10 Columbus Day
- Tues, October 18 Parent/teacher conferences
- Mon-Fri, Nov 21-25 Thanksgiving Holidays

Ways to Register:

- In person: You may register in person by coming to the school office at 11140 Greenbay St. and turning in a completed registration form along with payment. Enrollment will not be confirmed until payment is received. The school office hours are Monday – Friday, 9:00 am – 2:00 pm. The school offices will be closed November 21-25th for the Thanksgiving holidays.
- Online: You may register online by going to the school's website at www.chapelwood.org, click on ministries, and choose Chapelwood School for Young Children. A list of classes will appear on the screen. You may pay by credit card or debit to your checking account. There is a \$5 convenience fee for paying by credit card.

Wait lists and Minimum Enrollment:

- If a class fills to capacity, a wait list will be offered on a first-come, first-serve basis. Parents will be notified if there is a cancellation or if the instructor can accommodate additional students.
- Instructors determine class size and class schedules – some classes have a minimum enrollment. Parents will be notified 2 weeks prior if a class will not make due to low enrollment.

Refunds and Cancellations:

- Full refunds will be given if a class does not make the minimum enrollment requirements.
- There is a \$25 non-refundable administration fee (\$60 for the art class) for cancellations made before September 6, 2011.
- There will be no refunds after 12:00 pm, September 12, 2011.

Class Pickup:

- Students who are enrolled in the day school will be escorted to classes by the instructors.
- Parents will need to pickup students at the enrichment classroom - children will not be escorted back to the day school at the end of class.
- Parents who are late picking up their children may be charged a fee by the instructor.
- Please be sure to list emergency contact #'s and all persons authorized to pick up your child on the registration form.

Art for All Houston offers classes for children aimed at all levels of a child's artistic development. Classes provide semi-private, individual instruction through art history and art making. We encourage children to think creatively and experiment with techniques in drawing, painting, sculpture, and collage. Our goal is to promote original thinking, problem solving, and self-expression. Emphasis is on the process, not the product. We begin each class with prayer, discuss an artist using video, books, and stories, and their period in history, then make art borrowing from that artist's style. Class size is limited to 10 students, minimum enrollment is 4 students.
